### English

What your child should know -

- What a phoneme is the sounds that letters make.
- What a grapheme is the letters that represent the phoneme.
- How to decode regular words using phonic knowledge.
- To read and understand simple sentences.
- How to orally compose a sentence.
- To write some phonetically plausible simple sentences.

#### Maths

What your child should know -

- Recognise and order numbers 0-10.
- Recognise numbers as words.
- Count, read and write forwards and backwards 0-10.
- Count on from any number.
- Match numerals with the correct quantity.
- How to sort and group objects by specific features.

**Science -** Know about the characteristics of each of our seasons.

What your child should know -

- The names of the four seasons and the months associated with each.
- About the type of weather in each season.
- Observe and know about the changes in the seasons.

Geography - What do I know about the UK and where I live in Norden?

What your child should know -

- How to use maps to locate the four countries of the UK, their capital cities and the main seas.
- What an address and postcode is.
- How to use a local map to find the streets around our school.
- What road signs tell us.
- The names of their nearest towns and cities.

# R.E. - What does it mean to belong to a faith community?

What your child should know -

- What it means to belong to different groups (outside religion).
- About the symbols of belonging to at least two religions.
- What happens at a Christening or baptism.
- About what happens at a marriage.
- Why some people do not belong to any religion.

### Music – Music from Norden and Manchester

What your child should know -

- About the music of local, famous musicians.
- How to sing and recreate parts of the music of local famous musicians.
- How to use basic musical notation from a given set of notes.

# Computing

What your child should know -

- How to keep safe while using the internet.
- The importance of keeping safe while online.
- How to use purple mash effectively.

# Art – Drawing – Close Observation

What your child should know -

- About the work of the artist and illustrator Beatrix Potter.
- How to use a sketchbook to gather and collect ideas.
- How to use a viewfinder and lens appropriately.
- The difference between pencil grades.

### Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE)

What your child should know -

- The importance of rules and responsibilities.
- The characteristics of friendships including mutual respect and that in wider society they should be treated with respect as well as them giving respect.
- How to consider the views of others.

### P.E. –

What your child should know -

- How to negotiate space successfully.
- How to show increasing control over an object.
- How to move through obstacles skilfully.
