Vocabulary	
<b>oesophagus</b>	This is like a stretchy tube that moves food from the back of the throat to the stomach
<b>stomach</b>	This a hollow, muscular organ that stores food and passes it along in small amounts to the intestines for digestion.
<b>intestine</b>	The small intestine absorbs nutrients and minerals from food. The large intestine absorbs water from the remaining indigestible food
<b>incisors</b>	These are teeth that are used for cutting and slicing food and are at the front of the mouth.
<b>molars</b>	These are teeth that are used for chewing and grinding our food
<b>canine</b>	These are teeth used for ripping and tearing our food. We have two located at the top of our mouth and two at the bottom
